Recommendation

On September 10, 2013, the Department received a renewal State Only Operating Permit Application (SOOP) for Hanson Aggregates BMC, Inc. / Rich Hill Quarry located in Bullskin Township, Fayette County. Hanson has complied with the municipal notification requirements contained in 25 Pa. Code §127.413 and the application fee requirements contained in 25 Pa. Code §127.703(b)(3). This facility is a limestone crushing and processing facility. On September 12, 2013, the Department determined the renewal application was administratively complete. The previous operating permit was issued on April 22, 2009 and expired April 22, 2014.

On March 22, 2014, the Notice of Intent to Issue was published in the PA Bulletin for a 30-day public comment period. On March 26, 2014, the proposed Operating Permit renewal was submitted to Hanson Aggregates and Gary Bronson, Air Quality Specialist, for review. Mr. Percha, Environmental Manager for Hanson Aggregates, requested a correction in the Miscellaneous Section of the proposed Operating Permit renewal. The facility consists of twelve petroleum storage tanks ranging from 250 gallons to 10,000 gallons. The proposed Operating Permit renewal listed a 2,500 gallon Diesel Fuel Underground Storage Tank. This tank is actually an above ground storage tank. This error has been corrected. No further comments have been received.

On June 17, 2014, a compliance inspection was performed by Mr. Gary Bronson, Air Quality Specialist. Mr. Bronson did not note any violations at the time of his inspection. I recommend that the State Only Operating Permit renewal for Hanson Aggregates BMC, Inc. / Rich Hill Quarry, SOOP 26-00020, be issued.
